Advocacy:

he JFC is currently working on the publication of Roadmap 2010 that will be a summary and review of our in depth focus group discussions held in a number of key sectors. The focus sectors are: 1) Agri Business, 2) Business Process Outsourcing, 3) Creative Industries, 4.) Infrastructure, 5) Manufacturing and Logistics, 6) Mining and 7) Tourism (including Medical Travel) and Retirement. This Roadmap is a working document and the Joint Chambers are scheduling meetings with the respective Secretaries representing these sectors to present the pertinent sections for discussion.

August 2 JFC representatives had a meeting with DOLE Secretary Rosalinda Baldoz to discuss objectives of the new DOLE leadership and present sections of the Roadmap relevant to DOLE. Such as: flexible work arrangements, minimum wage policy and holiday economics.

August 3 Sent a letter to DENR Sectretary Ramon Paje expressing our concerns over the Writ of Kalikasan, Open Pit Mining Ban and possible repeal of the Mining Act of 1995. The JFC would like a clear message from the DENR for the foreign investment community in regards that the current

<u>August 18</u> JFC and industry representatives met with Secretary Ivan UY of CICT to present the BPO section of the Roadmap and discuss key issues that are important to the future continued growth of this sector.

<u>August 27</u> JFC representatives met with DPWH Secretary Rogelio Singson to present the Roadmap. Topic of discussion focused on

the Secretaries transformation framework for DPWH for full transparency & accountability to the people & to reduce corruption.

<u>August 31</u> Met with Secretary Purisima of DOF and Secretary Domingo of DTI to present our Roadmap and recommendations. In conclusion the JFC will be meeting on a regular bi-monthly basis to continue to discuss and work through issues of concern to our respective chamber interests.
