Barrett was previously the senior policy advisor to the Canadian Foreign and Trade Ministers with a focus on Asia, international trade and security issues.

Barrett is a Commonwealth Scholar and holds a Master's Degree (with Merit) in International Relations from the Victoria University of Wellington with an Honours Degree in Military and Strategic Studies from the Royal Military College of Canada. He was also Visiting Fellow at the Indonesian Centre for Strategic and International Studies, publishing on trade, piracy, and terrorism in the South China Sea.



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
